



lobate lac scale

Scales are approx 1/16th inch, shaped like an “x” with four lobes.

Pretty picture, isn't it?

Yeah! ... about as pretty as a Hurricane!

Attention: Landscapers, Designers, Maintenance Personnel, Nurserymen.

New Concern about the Lobate Lac Scale

In South Florida, & spreading; it feeds on 120+ species; **39 natives**.
causes dieback and plant death.

Cocoplum and **Wax-myrtle** are *highly susceptible*.

Builds up on popular natives, unnoticed, **spreads rapidly** to other plants,
quickly devastates your landscape.

Take action now! Don't let lobate lac scale get away from you:

On low populations, **horticultural oil** can control it.
Higher populations require bigger guns – use

imidacloprid (Merit in the landscape, Marathon in the nursery) and
thiamethoxam (Flagship in the nursery).
