The State (University of Florida) provides:

- 100% of the salary for 3 program assistants
- 60% salary for 2 4-H extension agents
- Citizens benefit from free, research based, educational curriculum and programs.

The County (under the Department of Consumer Services) provides:

- 100% salary for 1 4-H agent and 1 secretary
- 40% salary for 2 4-H agents
- Miami International Mall (1455 NW 107 Ave., Suite 906, Miami, 33172) provides free space for educational trainings and programs for youth and adults.

Did You Know?

- Senator Bob Graham is a 4-H alumnus
- Florida 4-H celebrated 100 years in 2009 (approximately 75 years in Miami-Dade)
- 4-H is the world's largest youth development organization: with 8 million members nationwide, 250,000 in Florida and over 9,000 in Miami-Dade County
- 4-H experiential, hands-on, education is provided free in schools, parks, libraries, after school programs, churches, and homes.
- 4-H started the Dade County Fair in 1952 and had over 2,500 exhibits (& \$6,000 in prize money) in 2009.
- 4-H is a recognized youth organization and valuable for acceptance into college or employment.
- 100% of Miami 4-H'ers, with membership over four years, all graduate from high school.

Statistics for 2008 - 2009

- 9,000 in 4-H youth membership, trained and supported by 6 staff and 1022 volunteers
- 1022 volunteers donated over 7302 hours worth \$137,058 (@ \$18.77/ hour)
- \$42,000 was donated through corporate and individuals gifts.
- 6 staff taught 798 group events reaching 17,654 children (50%, Hispanic; 28%, Black (inc. Haitian); 21%, White; 1% Other (Asian & Seminole))
- volunteers taught 2,244 group events reaching 103,053 children
