Key Steps to Developing A Hurricane Plan

Lack of awareness and lack of preparation are common threads among hurricane disasters. Knowing your vulnerability and actions you should take may reduce the effects of a hurricane disaster.



Learn about your community's emergency plan, evacuation routes and locations of emergency shelters.

Take photos of your home inside and out.

Videotaped documentation of all valuables in home.

Develop and review family evacuation plan.

Purchase or prepare a "First Aid Kit."

Check and replenish hurricane supplies.

Trim trees early.

Shop for a 3-7 day supply of water and non-perishable food.

Inspect shutters.

Post emergency phone number at every phone.

Make plans for persons with special needs, and pets.

Review insurance policies and make copies.

Prepare a "Family Document Kit."

Take an itemized inventory of household goods.
