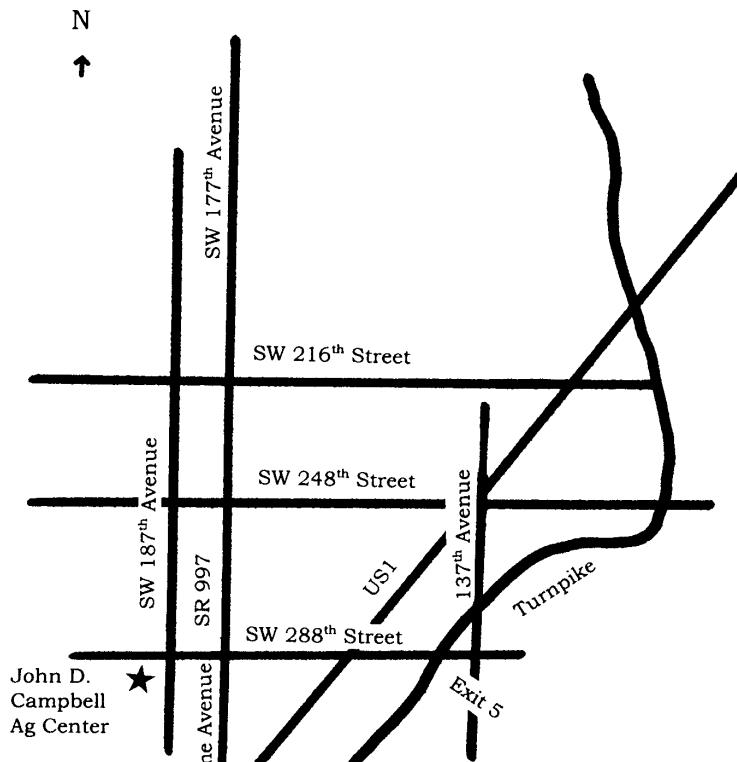


Directions to the John D. Campbell Ag Center: Take the Florida Turnpike to SW 288th Street exit (Exit 5). Turn **west** (right if coming from the North) on **SW 288th Street** and go ~5 miles to **SW 187th Avenue** (Redland Rd.), a 4-way stop sign – one mile west of Krome Avenue. The John D. Campbell Ag Center is on the **southwest** corner. **OR** Take the Turnpike (Homestead Extension) **south** to Caribbean Blvd. exit (**Exit 12**). Turn **right** (west) and go to **U.S. 1** (~3 blocks). Turn **left** on U.S. 1. Go **south** ~11 miles to **SW 288th Street** (Biscayne Dr.). Turn **right** and go ~3 miles.

You **should** attend General Standards training if:

- you are a grower or you are employed by a grower. (You will also need to take the Private Applicator exam.)
- you work for a government agency or a corporation and you need a license in one or more of:
 - Aquatics
 - Ornamental & Turf
 - Right-of-Way
 - Ag Tree Crop or Ag Row Crop
 - Public Health
 - Natural Areas Mgt
- you need to take the Limited Certification Structural or Lawn & Ornamental Exam and would like a refresher course.
- you need CEUs to renew your license. This class grants 4.0 General Standards / Core CEUs.

You should **NOT** attend General Standards training if: you would like to start your own pest control company. A pest control company is one which applies pesticides to residential or commercial properties (lawns & ornamentals or household pests) on a "for hire" basis. If you need this license, please contact the Bureau of Entomology, Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services, at (850) 921-4177 for information on this license and its requirements.

Study materials for the exam / Class registration: **From the UF Miami-Dade County Extension: SM1 - Applying Pesticides Correctly** (Cost \$8.25 by check or Money Order **only** – must be picked up in person). **NOTE:** We **highly** recommend reading the book **before** you take the class or exam. This is a **new** exam, so the passing rate is not known. **Registration for the class must** be by mail or in person. Please use the form at the bottom of this page.

What must I bring to the class? You **must** bring a government-issued photo ID to take the exam. If you are attending for CEUs, please bring your license number. CEU Approval #8732. Bring a pen or pencil so you can take notes. This is a **closed book** exam.

When can I take the written exam? The General Standards Exam will be given at the end of the training.

Pesticide Training Class Policy: If you are unable to attend a training class, please call **at least** 24 hours in advance. If there is an **emergency** (death in the family, illness, accident or similar unavoidable conflict) after that point, please call **as soon as possible** after the class, preferably within a week. We will transfer your registration to the next identical class or the next class of your choosing. If you simply forget to show up, your payment is non-refundable and non-transferable.
